Thank you for introducing Senate Bill 246. The Delaware Healthcare Association (DHA) strongly supports this legislation.

SB 246 would allow a hospital to petition for a court-appointed guardian for a non-acute patient who has been a patent at the hospital for an extended period of time after having been abandoned by family. This petition would only be allowed after providing two notices to the patient, the patient's surrogate, or the patient's family if there is no surrogate, of the need to seek a guardian for the patient. This bill is important as there is currently no legal process for a Delaware hospital to seek the appointment of a guardian for a non-acute patient. As a result, Delaware's hospitals have seen hundreds of cases of extended stay patients languishing in the hospital long after their period of acuity.

DHA strongly supports SB 246 because allowing hospitals to petition for a guardian is an important step in helping patients, who no longer need to be in the hospital, to transition to a more appropriate care setting.

Thank you again for sponsoring SB 246 and we look forward to working with you and the members of the General Assembly to advance this important legislation.
