Representative Minor-Brown,

Thank you for introducing House Substitute 2 for House Bill 344. The Delaware Healthcare Association (DHA) is pleased to support this bill.

HS 2 for HB 344 seeks to provide optimal health outcomes for all.

It seeks to address disparities in health care by directing a subcommittee of the Delaware Perinatal Quality Collaborative (DPQC) to develop guidelines for cultural competency training programs for use by hospitals and freestanding birthing centers in employee training and education programs. Program training would include diversity, inclusion, and address implicit/unconscious bias.
