As adopted by the Delaware Healthcare Association's Human Trafficking Medical Committee

## For Adults:

- 1. Do you know where you are?
- 2. Can you come and go as you please?
- 3. If you work,
  - a) do you have control of your earnings? Or do you have a debt to someone?
  - b) could you quit your job if you wanted to?
  - c) are you allowed to take breaks at work?
- 4. Has anyone threatened to hurt you or your family if you leave?
- 5. Do you carry your own identification?

- 2. Have you ever traded sex for money, food or gifts?
- 3. Have you ever been forced to work against your will doing something unfair/unsafe or dangerous?
- 4. Have you or your family members been threatened harm if they didn't work?
