Dear Senator Coons,

On behalf of the members of the Delaware Healthcare Association (DHA) I am writing to thank you for your support of the NOPAIN Act which will help us fight back against the opioid crisis.

Even before the pandemic started, the number of opioid overdoses were increasing as synthetic opioids <u>became more prevalent</u> across the country. Then, during the pandemic, overdoses <u>increased drastically</u>, putting additional stress on hospital systems as they were already caring for the waves of coronavirus patients coming in through their doors.

To turn the tide in our fight against the opioid epidemic, we must take a look at where addiction starts. For some that starts after receiving opiates to treat post-operative pain. While there are a number of FDA approved non-opioids, biological treatments, and medical devices available for treating pain, current Medicare policies limit patient's access to these options. The NOPAIN Act would change all this by unbundling payments made to hospitals so that a patient, in consultation with their doctor, would be able to receive a non-opioid pain management option. They would be able to leave the hospital without having to worry about the possibility of getting addicted to a powerful opioid.

This bill will slow the opioid epidemic and give much needed relief and support to our hospitals as they continue to care for Delaware patients.

Thank you again for co-sponsoring the NOPAIN Act. I ask you to work with your colleagues, including Senators Wyden and Schumer to encourage them to support the NOPAIN Act as well. Thank you.
