Further expands free breakfasts in schools participating in the federal School Breakfast Program by making them available to all students, regardless of household income, but does not expand free lunch income eligibility.

The Uniform Law Commission found that the word "other" was added in error to the final Uniform Health-Care Decisions Act.

Updates the terminology used to describe or citations used to reference those who make financial or health-care decisions on behalf of a principal or individual, including when that principal or individual lacks capacity.

Updates the Respiratory Care Advisory Council to the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline's to allow qualified licensed respiratory therapists to perform all duties associated with extracorporeal life support.

Governor Carney's Fiscal Year 26 Budget.

Expands the definition of "patient-practitioner relationship" to include practitioners and patients, that provide and seek treatment for, opioid use disorder.

Requires the managing entities of certain buildings acquire and place at least 6 trauma kits in a clearly visible, centrally located, and accessible area.

Requires that employers (of 11 or more employees) include salary or wage range information in all postings for job opportunities, both internally and externally.

Expands the practice of occupational therapy to include "dry needling" but may not be performed without a physician referral.

Enacts the Interstate Compact for School Psychologists, designed to facilities the interstate practice of school psychologist in school settings



This Act prohibits food establishments from providing any single-use food service items, whether plastic or not, unless specifically requested by a customer.



Expands free meals to all public school students in schools participating in the federal School Breakfast and National School Lunch Programs, regardless of household income.



Legalizes medical aid in dying also known as end of life options for terminally ill individuals.
